"It is our honor to work with physicians from Latin America who are dedicated to reducing and eradicating pain," said Dr. Fox. "Dr. Pereira and I know that by sharing our experience with these doctors, we can help people throughout the Americas who have been living with pain. The goal of the conference is to educate pain physicians from Latin American countries including Brazil and Venezuela about pain management and interventional pain techniques. 32 physicians will be attending the three-day conference, with hands on training during the cadaver workshops.

The symposium will be held at the Miami Anatomical Research Center. Organizers are planning to demonstrate an array of procedures including vertebral compression fracture procedures, percutaneous disc decompression, facet injections, transforaminal epidural steroid injections, radiofrequency denervation and spinal cord stimulation. The program is endorsed by World Institute of Pain.
